According to the records of the Ancient Christian Fellowship Review, as researched by Archbishop Wadle; Joseph R. Villatte was consecrated for the United States, Cuba, and the Latin American Countries in the Jacobite Antiochian succession in Ceylon, India June 5, 1892. Through this line of succession the Antiochian Church was eventually joined through Wadle and Spruit, bringing twelve lines of Apostolic Succession held by the Federation of Independent Catholic and Orthodox Bishops to the Old Catholic Episcopal Church.
